

Religious Education

This term, we will be looking at our key question of 'How does faith help people when life gets hard?' We will look at a variety of different faiths, including Christianity, and the children will further investigate their own worldviews.

Mathematics

In Mathematics this term, we will be moving firstly to shape. The children will investigate angles, 3D shapes and circles. We will then be moving on to algebra, ratio and finishing off the term with statistics.

Literacy—Writing

For our writing this half term, we will be focusing on poetry and non-fiction. We will be looking at 'The Lost Words', a beautiful watercolour book filled with a variety of different poetry styles. We will also be finishing the term with Extreme animals— an information text investigating the lives of animals living in a variety of different habitats.

Physical Education

We will focus on striking and fielding in PE this term. Mr Luxa will continue to teach on a Tuesday, and PE will continue to be on a Friday with Miss Symns.

Reading

We will continue to use the VIPERS (Vocabulary, Infer, Predict, Explain, Retrieve and Summarise/ Sequence) during our whole-class guided reading sessions. The texts will contain information that will benefit the children in their other subjects, such as information texts about habitats and volcanoes.

The children should continue to note down their reading from home and school in their reading record. The children will also continue to use AR to assess their comprehension of the books.

Expressive Arts and Design

Music: We will continue to investigate creating music using Charanga, looking at applying lyrics to soundtracks that the children produce. There will also be an emphasis on preparation for our production— rehearsing lines and learning the songs!

DT: Our DT topic will be looking at sculpture and 3D. We will also be preparing for the summer play, with lots of probs and sets to be made for our production!

Foundation Subjects

Science: The children will continue to look at living things and their habitats from last term. We will then be moving on to animals, including humans. This will investigate inheritance of characteristics and reproduction.

Geography/history: This half term, we will be finishing our previous topic of volcanoes. In history, we will be looking at the question 'Trojan horse: fact, myth or legend?'

PSHE: This term we are looking at 'changing me'. This will include how our bodies change during puberty, as well as relationships.
